



ENDOWMENT FUND SCHOLARSHIP GUIDE

PURPOSE

The King of Glory Endowment Fund awards scholarships to support the education of King of Glory members at Lutheran colleges and universities and thereby the growth and ministry of the KOG congregation as a whole.

PROCESS

KOG members who are attending a Lutheran College or University during the 2019-2020 school year are eligible for a scholarship from the KOG Endowment. Applications must be completed by each applicant and submitted via e-mail to the Pastor at Pastor@kogchurch.org and the current Endowment President at endowment@kogchurch.org by July 15. Scholarships will be approved by the Endowment board by July 31 and presented to recipients in front of the congregation in early August.

Congregational Appearances - Applicants will be required to speak to the congregation on two occasions. The first is when the scholarships are presented at the two church services (8:00 AM and 10:30 AM) in August. Scholarship recipients will give a short talk and include information about their relationship with King of Glory, the school they are attending, and their plans for the coming school year. The second appearance would be at the end of the school year and would be a brief report on their past school year journey, including; challenges, accomplishments and faith development.

APPLICATION

Scholarship Award Consideration - applicant needs, amount of church involvement and the quality of the essay will be considered in awarding the scholarship and determining the amount.

Matching School Funds - some schools offer matching scholarship funds. It is the responsibility of the student to provide their school's required matching funds paperwork in a timely manner after the scholarship has been awarded, no later than September 15, so that the church office can include it with the student's scholarship funds for the student to obtain the match.
